INTRODUCTION

We are of late experiencing parking problems with aircraft returning to the BCAL Hanger following flight. It would seem patrons of the hangar are parking in the area shown in yellow hatch causing access and egress problems for KB Aviation and the operators of the Premier Hangar.

Please can we ask all users to avoid parking in this area (yellow hatching) and help us to avoid delaying KB Aviation/Premier users to go about their normal business.

The Premier Hangar operate larger aircraft and need increased wing clearance, thus they require a larger cleared area before they can manoeuvre adequately from their respective apron link taxiway. It's vital we respect and keep the link taxiway clear around the fuel pumps to the west.

The green area shown is for Municipal hangar based aircraft only. Should your aircraft block another, please inform the fire crew and ask them to relocate or hangar your aircraft if it's not to be used again.
